Farming today is a complex and difficult job; government regulations, spiraling costs, weather, and disease all take their toll on your operation. Farm theft and crime does not have to add to your problems.

Over time, crime, especially theft, can be the most costly problem that you'll face. It robs you of the very items you need to produce income. Dealing with farm crime is a never-ending, difficult and potentially dangerous issue, especially with today's decentralized operations.

Whether it's pecan orchards being stripped of nuts, cattle and crop theft, or someone stealing copper or equipment, it's impossible to continuously guard your operation alone. Thieves know this and take advantage of both distance and timing opportunities to steal.

Criminals see your operation as an easy target

Farm crime is on the rise and growing faster than urban crime. As the cost of living continues to rise, unemployment remains high, and the number of people living in poverty grows, rural crime will continue to increase.



What are your options

Local law enforcement cannot provide 24 hour protection. Limited budgets and increasing crime have local law enforcement struggling to keep crime in check. Protecting your property and guests falls to you.

Off-duty police officers is an option; they're qualified and trained. However, off-duty police are law enforcement first; security officers second. They are restricted in how they deal with security issues and are required to respond to any observed violation whether on-or-offsite. They must report if recalled to duty for emergencies or special events; leaving you unprotected.

Providing your own security guards will increase staffing and equipment costs. Also the insurance required can be cost prohibitive. In-house security can be effective if properly trained and equipped. However, poorly trained guards may behave unprofessionally, cause harm, or create legal problems.

Hiring unlicensed security guards: This is a risky and illegal approach (contract security must be state licensed). This option may appear cheap, but it can have devastatingly expensive results. If an unlicensed guard is injured or injures someone else (or worse), how much will it cost you? Your insurance may refuse coverage for the actions of unlicensed guards and you may be open to charges of negligence.

Other security companies: Only a few have the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively secure farms, ranches, and large land tract operations. These companies range from one-man operations to upscale security service companies with premium priced concierge services.



Dealing with farm crime can have consequences

Stopping crime can be time-consuming, costly, and dangerous. And dealing with a criminal act will take time away from productive work; often during the busiest time of the season.

If you injure or kill someone, even while they are committing a crime and on your property illegally, you can expect to be sued. Worse yet, you can be charged with a crime yourself.

Rural crime is twice as likely to turn violent as urban crime. If you try to deal with a crime alone, you can be placing yourself, your employees, or family members in harm's way, or in a lethal situation.

Safety Tips

Keep this list and feel free to make copies.

- Have a daily check-in routine for your family and employees.
- Complete background checks on all employees even temporary employees.
- Have an emergency response plan for: accidents, fire, chemical spills, flooding, or other emergencies.
- Have an emergency evacuation plan.
- Designate a helicopter pad site and provide the coordinates to local *life-flight* and emergency services.
(Make sure the area is obstacle free and accessible when wet.)
- Ensure staff has basic first-aid training
- Keep 1st Aid/Trauma kit on hand at all sites
- Keep a notebook of all dangerous substances and materials. Keep copies of Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) in a master binder.
- Teach your family and employees to be vigilant when at work or on the road. Teach the 3-right turn driving surveillance technique to everyone. (Call us if you don't know it)
- Try to never confront a criminal alone. Don't place yourself in danger for anything less than imminent peril to yourself, family or employees.
